The Teacher Recruiting in Mild/Moderate (TRIMM)

Licensure project has scholarships available for undergraduate, graduate, and license-only students seeking initial licensure in Special Education with Mild/Moderate specialization.



Candidates must be on track to complete their program

requirements for their initial teaching license with a Bachelor's degree, teaching license with a Master's degree, or a teaching license only.

TRIMM Scholarships are supported with IDEA funds from the Utah State Board of Education to address the critical shortage of teachers serving students with mild/moderate disabilities in Utah. Scholarships are made on a competitive basis and provide up to 2 years of funding

- Up to \$9,000 for *graduate students each year*
- Up to \$5,000 for *undergraduate students each year*
- Up to \$5,000 for students seeking *licensure only*
